The position is responsible for the following:

- Pick up food donations and other donations as they become available.
- Keep pantry area tidy and ensure products are well stocked
- Inspect food items to ensure quality of donations prior to distribution to clients
- Develop meal plans and shopping list that stays within budget and ensure purchase of needed supplies.
- Ensure all receipts and records are keep up to date and submitted to Finance
- Prepare food bags for clients for distribution, keeping dietary restrictions for individual clients in mind
- Return any milk crates and/or banana boxes to the Sudbury Food Bank from previous week(s).

The successful candidate:

- Must have a valid driver's license, clean driving record, and be insurable through the Agency's Insurance program.
- Excellent communication and time management skills
- Good organizational skills and administrative skills
- Willingness to shop at various locations to assure best value for budget.
- Able to move, lift and push heavy objects
- Strong ability to develop suggested nutritional meal plans while working within limited budgets.
- Experience working within a non-profit organization and/or with volunteers is an asset
- Comfortable working with people of all backgrounds (ie., sexual orientation, drug addiction)
- Self-directed and able to take initiative
- Ability to work independently and as a team member
